

HIGHLIGHTS OF LOT MAINTENANCE CONTRACT - (Page One of Two)

Mowing:

- 1. Grass areas will be cut every 7-10 days to a height of 3-3 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches.
 - 2. All small debris will be removed prior to cutting.
- 3. Trimming of grass around fences, trees, plant beds and light poles will be done with string trimmer.

Edging:

- 1. All sidewalks and driveways will be edged twice per month April thru October.
 - 2. All curbs will be edged the same day as sidewalks.
- 3. All debris created on sidewalks, driveways and curbs will be cleared away with a blower.
- 4. All tree, shrub and flower beds will be manually edged one time during spring mulching to create a 2" deep border.

Fertilizing:

- 1. Lawns (turf) are fertilized 4 times a year: April, May, September and October.
 - 2. Ornamental trees and shrubs are fertilized once in the spring.

Weed Control:

- 1. All grass areas will be treated for annual weed control including crabgrass twice in the spring.
- 2. All grass areas will be treated for broadleaf weeds (clover) as necessary from May through October.
 - 3. All areas adjacent to curbs and pavement will be treated once per month April thru October.
- 4. All tree, shrub and flower beds will be weeded by hand and/or sprayed to maintain good appearance at all times.

Mulching:

 All trees, shrubs and flower beds will be mulched once in the spring with a high quality dyed mulch and spot treated again with mulch in the fall as needed in order to maintain a good appearance.

Pruning:

- 1. All trees will be pruned once every 3 years during the dormant season (December-March). Certain ornamental trees and shrubs will be trimmed, hand pruned, thinned and/or shaped four (4) times per year from May 1 through October 31 in order to maintain a neat appearance. Large limb removals (over 6" diameter) or work which otherwise requires a special tree crew will be pruned at the homeowner's expense.
 - 2. Pruning of trees away from lights and to provide clearance of walkways will be done during each pruning cycle.

Trimming and Shaping:

1. Shrubbery will be pruned 4 times a year from May 1 through October 31.

Leaf Removal:

1. Will occur four times per year: twice in November, once in December and once in January.

Seeding:

1. ½ of every property in the community will be aerated and over seeded once a year in the fall. Additional seeding or sod installation will be at the homeowner's expense.

Party Cleanup:

1. Two party clean-ups are free of charge. Additional party clean-ups are at the discretion of the Landscape Contractor at a nominal charge. Minimum notice of 10 days is required.

ITEMS NOT COVERED IN THE CONTRACT - Homeowner's Responsibility

- 1. Watering
- 2. Replacement of dead plants there will be a charge for this service
 - 3. Grading of lawn areas
 - 4. Annual flower maintenance
- 5. Maintenance of native trees which were existing prior to development
 - 6. Removal/relocation of wild and dead animals
- 7. Mowing, clearing underbrush or maintenance of natural wooded areas
 - 8. Maintenance of roses
 - 9. Collection of personal garden debris
 - 10. Removal of dead plants and trees
 - 11. Storm damage debris removal
