PRIVACY POLICY (Page One of Three)

Avenel Community Association, Inc. (“Avenel”, “we”, or “us”) respects the privacy of your personal information.

This Privacy Policy is designed to assist you in understanding how we use and safeguard the information you provide in using our websites (“Sites”) and the services we provide (“Services”). Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. By using the Sites, you acknowledge and agree that you consent to this Privacy Policy.

Information We Collect:

Through your use of our Sites and Services, we may collect personal information, which is information that identifies you as an individual, relates to you as an identifiable individual, or that, along with other information, could identify you. We collect the following types of personal information:

Information Provided By You:

We do not require you to provide any personal information in order to navigate our Sites. However, we need to collect personal information if you choose to engage in certain activities on our Sites. We collect personal information from you when you:

- Create an account. In order to access the owner’s secure area on our Sites, you will be required to create an account. To do this, you will need to provide your Name and street address**

Information Automatically Collected from You:

We may automatically collect the following types of information as you use our Sites or Services:

- Usage Information. Which pages on our websites you access, the frequency of access, what you click on while on our Websites and when you accessed the websites.**
- Location Information. Information about your location, which may be determined through your IP address, and through GPS only if your settings are set up to allow the dissemination of your latitude/longitude coordinates.**
- Device Information. Information about the device you are using, such as hardware model, operating system, browser, and IP addresses.**

Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies:

•**Cookies.** “Cookies” are small pieces of information that are stored by your web browser software on your computer’s hard drive or temporarily in your computer’s memory. We place and store Internet cookies on your hard drive. Cookies enable us to personalize your viewing experience. When you revisit our Sites, we can recognize you by the cookie and customize your experience at the Sites accordingly. For example, we use cookies to recognize your access privileges to the Sites, track usage and traffic patterns of Sites, identify you and keep track of your preferences, prevent fraudulent activity or improve security of Sites, assess the performance of Sites, and estimate audience size of the Sites. Google Analytics. We use a tool called “Google Analytics” to collect some information we listed above about your use of the Services. We use the information we get from Google Analytics to improve the Services. In order to collect this information, Google Analytics may set cookies on your browser or mobile device, or read cookies that are already there. Google Analytics may also receive information about you from apps you have downloaded, that partner with Google. We do not combine the information collected through the use of Google Analytics with personally identifiable information. Google’s ability to use and share information collected by Google Analytics about your visits to the Services to another application which partners with Google is restricted by the Google Analytics Terms of Use and the Google Privacy Policy. How we use your information:
