

AVENEL COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION 2021 SWIM TEAM APPLICATION

The Avenel Swim Team welcomes all Avenel residents' children aged 5 to 18 (as of 6/3/21) to join the Avenel Alligators Swim Team for the 2021 season. In order to participate, children must be able to swim one length of the pool unassisted.

As a result of the continuing COVID-19 pandemic and the related county requirements and Avenel Community Association safety measures, this swim season will differ somewhat from those we have had in the past. Please note the following:

- We will have a Pre-Team program for younger children this year, but the program will not start until one week after Memorial Day.
- Each swimmer, parent/guardian and volunteer will be required to sign a waiver and comply with COVID-related safety procedures. Please see the waiver and Coaches' letter below for more detail.
- We will monitor changes in state and local requirements and overall safety considerations. <u>Swim</u> team practices, meets and other events, and swim team operating protocols will be subject to change as needed.

Swim Team practices begin the day after Memorial Day (Tuesday, June 1) and continue until late July. Additional information about the Swim Team, including meet dates, is available on the Avenel webpage at www.LiveAtAvenel.com.

Swim team practice will start on **Tuesday, June 1** from 5:45 - 7:45 pm (Monday to Friday) during the first week of opening, then 5:00 - 7:45 pm thereafter.

From June 1 to 4, practice will be held Tuesday to Friday:

10 and Under: 5:45-6:45 pm11 and Over: 6:45-7:45 pm

From June 7 until the end of the swim season, practice will be held Monday to Friday:

Pre-Team: 5:00-5:30 pm
10 and Under: 5:45-6:45 pm
11 and Over: 6:45-7:45 pm

Please complete the application attached hereto, including the required volunteer section and the signatures of the child's parent(s) or legal guardians, <u>and</u> payment of the applicable <u>registration fee of \$295 per child</u>; if you have three (3) or more children on the swim team, the discounted fee is \$260 per child. Please mail or drop off the application <u>by May 31</u> with your check (made payable to "Avenel Community")

Association") at the ACA Office, located at 9501 Beman Woods Way, Potomac, Maryland 20854. There is a drop box located to the left of the front door. All checks will be held until June 1, 2021.

Swimmers who are not registered or have not provided the required waivers before the first practice will not be permitted to participate in any team activities, including practice, until they are properly registered and paid.

Volunteer Policy for Avenel Alligator Families

Volunteers are crucial for any youth athletic organization to function. We greatly appreciate the time that parents volunteer to the team because we cannot have a team without them! Based on our research of other swim teams' volunteer requirements, we have adopted the following volunteer policy, which we believe to be fair and manageable.

The following volunteer policy applies to the parents/guardians of <u>all</u> Avenel Alligators swimmers who compete in team swim meets:

1. Team families are required to volunteer for <u>a MINIMUM of two (2) slots</u> at swim meets and/or swim team social events over the course of the season. Please volunteer more than twice if you can as we need more than this number of volunteers to run the team for the summer. Please note that the Volunteer Options include some purchases or contributions for the team that may be made in lieu of volunteering your time.

- 2. If a parent is unable to volunteer, you may find a substitute (another parent or family member (age 16+), or adult guardian, such as a nanny or babysitter, who speaks fluent English) to fulfill your requirement.
- 3. If you have not fulfilled your volunteer requirement by the date of the last meet of the season (July 15), your swimmer will not be allowed to participate in Divisionals, Relays, or Champs. The only exception is volunteers whose second volunteer slot <u>has been confirmed</u> to be at Champs or the season-end banquet.
- 4. When volunteering, please sign the volunteer check-in sheet located at the Pool's front desk in order to receive credit for your participation. It is the volunteer's responsibility to sign in and to remain for the entire session he/she is working, regardless of when his/her swimmers' races are completed.

There are two home swim meets at the Avenel Pool on June 29 and July 13 this year, for which we will need many volunteers. Volunteers are also needed for our away meets on June 15 (10 and Under only), June 17 and 22, and July 6 (Relay Carnival), 8 and 15, and 20 (Divisionals). Championships will be held at Congressional Country Club on July 26 and 27 for swimmers who qualify. We will have a team social event outdoors (tentatively scheduled for the evening of Friday, June 25, with a rain date of Friday, July 9), and our post-season Banquet and Paper Plate Awards are tentatively scheduled for July 28 from 5:30-8:00 pm. All of these events require volunteers. Please note that these dates and the logistics/approach associated with the events are subject to change due to weather, COVID-19, scheduling conflicts, etc.

OTHER OPTIONS FOR FULFILLING YOUR VOLUNTEER SLOTS (circle your choice):

- 1. Sponsor the swim team for \$500 (or find a sponsor) and get your (or sponsor's) business' name advertised on the team banner; a custom plaque; recognition in the team video; plus your business' name on the entrance board for the entire season in the foyer of the Swim Club. The sponsoring business also will be listed in a "thank-you" ad/article in *Avenel Living Magazine* at season's end. This would fulfill <u>both</u> of a family's volunteer obligations.
- 2. Donate \$300 for a new Records plaque for the Clubhouse foyer. This would fulfill <u>both</u> of a family's volunteer obligations.
- 3. Donate \$275 toward the purchase of trophies or medals for all swimmers, to be given out at Banquet. This would fulfill <u>both</u> of a family's volunteer obligations.
- 4. Pay \$150 for <u>each</u> volunteer slot you cannot fulfill so that we can hire a replacement from the pool management company (a total of \$300 if you cannot fulfill either of your family's two-slot obligation).
